## **HISTORY OF HOMOEOPATHY**

The Homoeopathic System of Medicine is based on the natural law of Healing “ **Similia Similibus Curenture**” meaning “Likes are cured by the Likes”. The founder of Homoeopathy Dr.Sammual Hahnemann (1755-1843) a German Doctor M.D. from University of Leipzig, gave it scientific basis in 19<sup>th</sup> Century.

The history of Homoeopathy in India is linked with the name of Dr. Honigber a French man who brought Homoeopathy in India, who arrived at Lahore in 1829-1830 and later on went to Calcutta.

In April 1937, Mr. Ghais-ud-Din moved a resolution in the Legislative Assembly for recognition of Homoeopathy, which was passed and Bengal was the first province to constitute a homoeopathic State Faculty in 1943.

In Pakistan Homoeopathic System of Medicine was recognized at the Government level through UAH Act of 1965. This Act of Parliament regulates the educational system through the establishment of National Council for Homoeopathy.

## **INTRODUCTION**

National Council for Homoeopathy is an Autonomous Body established under Section 3 of Unani Ayurvedic and Homoeopathic Practitioners Act, 1965, II of 1965.

The office of N.C.H. is located in its own building situated at Fazil Town (Phase-I), Airport Link Road, Rawalpindi.

## **VISION/OBJECTIVE**

To promote and popularize Homoeopathic System of Medicine, to regulate education, research in and to provide for the registration of practitioners of this system of medicine.

## **FUNCTIONS**

As per Section 14 of the U.A.H. Act, 1965, functions of the Council are as under:-

- i) to consider applications for recognition under this act made by the institutions imparting or desiring to impart instruction in the system of medicine with which the Council is concerned;
- ii) to secure the maintenance of an adequate standard of education in recognized institutions;
- iii) to make arrangements for the registration of duly qualified persons in accordance with the provisions of this Act;
- iv) to appoint committees or sub-committees, each having due representation of all the

Provinces, for a specific period, to perform any specified function concerned with the functions of the Council;

- v) to provide research in the system of medicine with which the Council is concerned; and
- vi) to do such other acts and things as it may be empowered or required to do by this Act or the rules.
